



Integrated management system (IMS) Policy

CRH is a leading producer and supplier of construction materials – cement, aggregates and concrete – in the North Danube cluster formed by CRH businesses located in Slovakia, Hungary and Austria. In Slovakia, transport of raw materials and products, produced in CRH's plants in Rohožník and Turňa nad Bodvou, is provided by companies TransPlus, which are also a part of CRH North Danube cluster. It also includes the ecorec group, a leading producer of alternative fuels in the Central and Eastern Europe. These fuels are produced from industrial and sorted municipal waste and are energetically recovered in CRH (Slovensko) a.s. cement plants.

This IMS Policy is a strategic document which we undertake to follow in our activities and in the development of our activities in the areas of quality management, health and safety, and environment in all companies of the CRH group in the North Danube cluster. This policy is a commitment for increasing the IMS effectiveness and at the same time provides a framework for establishing goals and programs in compliance with CRH values.

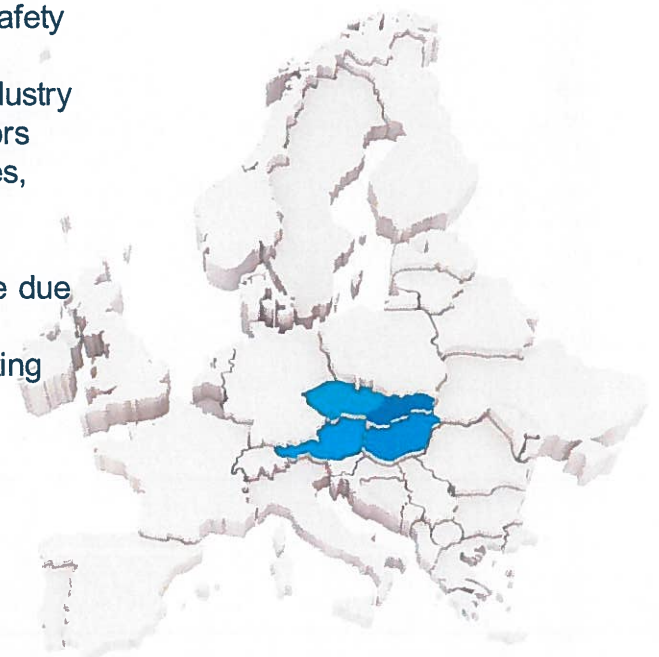
Quality

CRH intensified its efforts to eliminate fatalities from all operations and introduced enhanced procedures to ensure that circumstances surrounding such events are promptly identified, and that lessons learned are communicated throughout the Group as a matter of urgency. Zero harm is a key objective across CRH. CRH Group will continue to devote substantial management and all the appropriate resources to this area to progress Group performance towards these targets.

Environment

Sustainability is a core value for CRH Group and we are committed to the highest standards of environmental management in all of our activities. Our management systems in this regard are well established and are regularly reviewed, considering industry best practice. Knowledge sharing around the CRH Group also plays an important part in this process. Furthermore, our policy which applies across all companies requires us to:
